- Fect user: For best results, it is important to place the unit on the floor near an open window or door so that clean cool air is circuitted at all times. Faither to do this can cause an odour due to the same air bing no-circuitate. If an odour is present, sirrely change the water and move the unit to an open window or door so fresh cool is a circuitated at all times.

- 1. The appliance is to be operated by responsible soluts only after reading and understanding these instructions. - Do not repair or make mechanical alterations to the appliance. It should be repaired by a qualified person or returned to the distributor if faulty.


- 7. When the appliance is not in use, switch it off and unplug.

- 10. Only use the appliance on a flat surface.

- After adding water to the water tank, do not tilt or knock over the appliance. The unit should remain stable on a flat surface once water is added to avoid spilage.
- 14. Do not turn the appliance over. If it is knocked over with water in the unit, turn off and unplug from the power supply immediately. The unit should then be checked by a qualified person or returned to your place of purchase for examination and repair.
- Clean the unit with a light damp cloth. Do not use any type of detergent or chemical solution.

- Do not use the appliance in the proximity of a bath, shower, swimming pool or any other body of water.

- Assembling castors: Put the appliance on a flat surface and simply push the casters securely into place.

 Tank: Simply open the top lid and pull out the white rubber burng and pour the water in from the top, remember to only fill to the max level shown on the water indicator on the front of the unit on the water trank. When the water trank is full, remember to place the rubber burng back.

WARNING: Ensure that the fan is switched off from the mains supply and unplugged before attempting to clean any part of the unit.

We recommend changing the water on a daily basis to help keep the paper evaporator water filter and tank clean and free from odours.
